Rosemary is an interpretive Naturalist with years of experience providing environmental education and recreation therapy programs for individuals with cognitive and physical disabilities. Rosemary holds degrees from MSU and the University of Wisconsin and has spent her entire career working with children, youth and adults in camps, schools, in the out of doors.

Our camp staff also includes a certified lifeguards, health officer, camp counselors and culinary staff. Our enthusiastic staff is required to attend a week long training program that includes First-Aid, CPR,

waterfront and boating safety. Specialized training will all be given in working with children and adults that are cognitively impaired.

### Medical

As a state licensed camp we are required to have a health officer at camp at all times. Our camp doctor is on call 24 hours a day. Your camper's individualized medical conditions and needs are important to our staff. Please make sure to share all information that will help make this a successful experience for all.
