Water Front Job Descriptions

Duties

- ▶ Serve as a tent counselor during non-waterfront activities
- ▶ Improve swimming skills of campers by incorporating water games and activities making the experience fun and safe.
- ▶ Maintain continuous supervision of the campers when in the water; act immediately and appropriately to secure safety of the campers in the event of emergency.
- ▶ Give emergency care and treatment as needed until emergency medical service is available.
- ▶ Maintain a professional appearance and manner at all times.
- ▶ Manage water craft activities, equipment, maintenance and instruction – canoes, kayaks, and life vests
- ▶ Performs assorted job-related duties as assigned.

Qualifications

- ▶ Minimum 18 years of age
- ▶ Certifications (Must submit originals upon hire)
 - American Red Cross Lifeguard Training or equivalent (training available)
 - CPR for the Professional Rescuer (training available)
 - First Aid (training available)

- ▶ Aquatic Observers
