Rose Lake Youth Camp History

Rose Lake Youth Camp was started in 1948 with the goal of providing a positive camping experience to thousands of children in northern Michigan. The camp is a non-profit corporation, licensed by the State of Michigan. Our mission is to provide children the opportunity to spend five days living and experiencing nature's treasures and outdoor wonders. Each camp session is limited to 48 campers, allowing our camp staff to get to know each child and help them experience the wonders of this special and fragile world.

Health and Safety #1 Priority Health Officer on duty 24/7

Trained Lifeguards supervise all water activities.

Staff are carefully screened and must pass background checks and attend a week long training and orientation session.

Licensed by The State Of Michigan-Camp Licensing Division

Campers sleep in screened platform tents that sleep up to seven people including a counselor.

Meals are prepared by our food

service team and include fresh salad bars at lunch and dinner; our breakfast bar includes fruit, cereals, homemade granola and yogurt. All meals have hot food choices for your camper to select from. Please provide advance notice of any dietary concerns, we are happy to work with you.

Resident Camp is a coed overnight camp. It is a summer favorite, featuring outdoor activities, outdoor cooking, campfires and enjoying nature for a week. Due to the overnight nature of this camp, campers fully immerse themselves in traditional camp activities include special campfire activities and evening group activities. Ages 7-13.

Explorer Resident Camp - Join us for a 3 day/2 night mini camp! Includes all the fun of our resident camp sessions, geared for campers who are not yet ready for a full week of resident camp. July 26th - 28th.

Day Camp

Always popular Day Camp is a favorite for many children. This session runs from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. The Day Camp price includes breakfast, lunch and a snack. This is a great introduction to camp life and activities and focuses on age appropriate all-time favorite camp activities. For campers needing early drop-off or later pick-up times, before and after day camp care will be available as early at 8am and as late as 6pm for an additional fee on the camp registration form. Ages 4-13.

Day Camp has an optional Thursday overnight, allowing children to get a taste of resident camp. The Thursday Overnight includes dinner and an evening snack. Children will enjoy campfires and special events and games not offered during the normal Day Camp day. If you would like your child

to participate, please indicate this option on the camp registration. The minimum age for the overnight is 7 years of age.

Explorer Day Camp-3 Day Session *Our mini day camp session is offered Monday-Wednesday for \$75.00, you can upgrade to a full week session for \$25.00 more. July 13th - 15th.*
