Rose Lake Youth Camp was started in 1948 with the goal of providing a positive camping experience to thousands of children in northern Michigan. The camp is a non-profit corporation, licensed by the State of Michigan. Our mission is to provide children the opportunity to spend five days living and experiencing nature's treasures and outdoor wonders. Each camp session is limited to 48 campers, allowing our camp staff to get to know each child and help them experience the wonders of this special and fragile world.

Modified registration check in, daily health screenings, additional hand sanitizing stations, modified meal serving and more frequent cleaning of camp facilities are part of our procedures.

Health Officer on duty 24/7

Trained Lifeguards supervise all water activities.

Staff are carefully screened and must pass background checks and attend a weeklong training and orientation session.

Licensed by The State Of Michigan-Camp Licensing Division

Campers sleep in screened platform tents that sleep up to seven people including a counselor.

Meals are prepared by our food service team and include fresh salad bars at lunch and dinner; our breakfast bar includes fruit, cereals, homemade granola and yogurt. All meals have hot food choices for your camper. Please provide advance notice of any dietary concerns, we are happy to work with you.
